

Flooding in Kilgarvan

I have written to Kerry County Council asking them to fix the drain that is continuously blocked across the road from Dillons shop in Kilgarvan.

I believe some work was done on it in the recent past but this has not proven to be successful. The Council have informed me that the Water Services Department are aware of the problem and are dealing with it.

Graveyard in Kilgarvan

Due to underlying rock close to the surface, the number of plots remaining may not be as many as it would appear. I asked Kerry County Council to look into this with a view to possibly looking for locations for a new graveyard.

I have been told that by the Council that there are sufficient spaces for the next two years and that the Council intends to acquire additional space when necessary.

Pedestrian Traffic Around Kenmare

A number of residents have raised concerns to me about sandwich boards, tables and chairs being put on the streets around Kenmare that are impeding pedestrian traffic on the streets in particular buggies and wheelchairs.

I have asked the Council to look into this and to let me know what the rules and procedures are for this.

Cill Mhuire Estate

I have been in contact with the Council asking them to alleviate the problem of water logging along the road to the Cill Mhuire estate.

I have also asked if the Council if they have any plans to extend the footpath Cill Mhuire to the Supervalu Centre on Railway Road.
